Rocky Mountain House

JFR Base Name: Shunda

Distance from Nearest Town/City: 36km - Nordegg

Brief Description: Each JFR member shares a small cabin with another member, tucked away in the woods beside the main initial attack fire base for the area. It is close to the mountains, famous Abraham Lake, Crescent Falls and many other natural attractions. There is a basketball court/hockey rink, full gym, large field for soccer and ultimate frisbee, many close by hikes and fishing lakes and national historic sites.

Projects crews have completed in previous years:

- Assist Raven Brood Trout hatchery with firesmarting projects
- Participate in mop-up of a wildfire
- Assist Alberta Parks in construction projects
- Work with Fisheries to capture and collect data from lake fish
- Tour a forestry sawmill and learn how trees are utilized from log to board

The JFR program aims to run a crew in 9 of 10 forest management areas, rotating which area(s) do(es) not have a crew annually. Activities in each forest area will vary from year to year.
